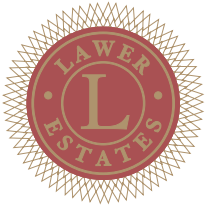

2015 CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Tasting Notes: The deep red and purple hues exhibit terrific depth and concentration, indicating the wine's solid structure. Aromas are rich, ripe and generous with notes of sweet blackcurrant, tobacco, and toasted oak. On the palate, these aromas are met with lavish cassis flavors and complemented by vanillin oak, solid tannin structure, and a lush framework. This wine will only get better with time. *CG & KD*
