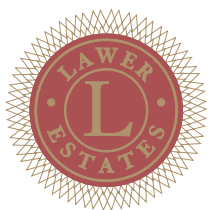

Tasting Notes: This Chardonnay bursts with enticing aromas of citrus, floral notes, caramel, lemon peel and a slight spicy quality. In the mouth, flavors of citrus, pear and honeysuckle combine with subtle toast and caramel. The mouth feel is full-bodied with a creamy texture that carries through to a round, clean finish that is balanced with just enough acidity. - *CG & KD*
