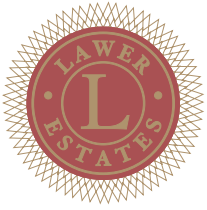

2017 SYRAH

Tasting Notes: The 2017 Syrah is dark purple with a ruby edge. This wine was co-fermented with 1.5% Viognier which added to the fruit complexity. The aroma has notes of fresh blackberries, baked cherry, ripe plum, tea and black pepper. The wine has a round central core of red fruit that gives way to a complex mid-palate full of cassis, dark cherry, spice, and vanilla that adds to the fine velvety tannic structure and richness, finishing very long. *CG & KD*
